Superbly sited in the northwest part of the Saint-Émilion appellation, Château La Dominique takes its name from an island in the Caribbean (Dominica) where the owner made his fortune. Acquired in 1969 by Clément Fayat, the vineyard has been entirely renovated and constantly improved ever since.

Bordering directly on châteaux Cheval Blanc, Figeac, L'Évangile and La Conseillante, this outstanding 30-hectare terroir consists of sand and clay where Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon reach full maturity to make great wine.

The vines are tended with meticulous care, and great attention is paid to winemaking and blending with help from the famous consultant Michel Rolland to produce deeply-coloured, generous, intense, opulent and silky wines in every vintage.

In keeping with La Dominique's prestigious reputation, Clément Fayat inaugurated an innovative new cellar, both in terms of its architecture and technical capabilities, in 2013. Designed by Jean Nouvel, this new building houses both a wine cellar and visitor reception area, and affords a magnificent view of the surrounding vineyards!
